The Hilton Foundation and City of Hope present a research-intensive three-week laboratory internship for rising juniors and seniors who will be 16 years old by the start of the program. This internship is for students who are interested in gaining hands-on laboratory experience, while exploring concepts such as the pathophysiology of heart disease, the implications of food deserts, and the differences between GMO, organic and conventionally grown foods. During the program, students will be asked to conduct an independent literature-based research project on a science and nutrition topic of their choosing, which they will present at the conclusion of the program.
