1983 - A \$10 million grant from the Arnold and Mabel Beckman Foundation establishes Beckman Research Institute of City of Hope.

1984 - City of Hope scientists, working in collaboration with scientists at Genentech, first demonstrate that antibodies can be made using recombinant DNA technology - technology that is later used in the "smart" cancer drugs Herceptin, Rituxan, Avastin, Erbitux and other therapeutic drugs.

1985 - City of Hope scientists develop a method for detecting carcinoembryonic antigen - a substance in the body that can indicate the presence of colon cancer - using antibodies produced by engineered cells.

1986 - The National Cancer Institute selects City of Hope as one of only six centers participating in a study of a drug called interleukin-2. Today, the drug is used to treat melanoma and kidney cancer.

1987 - Parsons Village is built, providing a place to stay on campus for patients and family members from outside the Los Angeles area.

1988 - A team of City of Hope scientists devise a test for detecting HIV that is more sensitive than existing methods.

1989 - City of Hope scientists develop ligation mediated genomic sequencing, a new method for analyzing genetic material.

1990 - Ribozymes, "molecular scissors," are successfully tested in City of Hope laboratories for their ability to clip out the genetic message of the HIV virus and render it harmless.

1991 - Preventive treatment methods are developed against cytomegalovirus interstitial pneumonia, a leading cause of death following bone marrow transplantation.

1992 - City of Hope establishes a gene therapy program and received a four-year grant from the National Institutes of Health/ National Cancer Institute.

1993 - A research consortium including City of Hope identifies a key gene, IRF-1, that is missing in some patients facing leukemia and a related syndrome called myelodysplasia.

1994 - City of Hope's graduate school - now the Irell & Manella Graduate School of Biological Sciences - is founded.

1995 - The National Comprehensive Cancer Network is established with City of Hope as a founding member. This alliance of leading cancer centers develops national standards of care for cancer treatments.

1996 - The Hardware/Home Improvement Industry Legacy Research Center, a home to basic science research that fuels future advances, is built.

A City of Hope scientist finds long-sought direct evidence linking smoking to lung cancer by identifying the genetic damage done by active compounds in cigarettes.

1997 - City of Hope becomes the first institution in the United States to begin testing the use of bone marrow transplantation and ribozyme-based gene therapy to treat HIV/AIDS.

1998 - The National Cancer Institute, or NCI, designates City of Hope as a comprehensive cancer center, one of only 35 in the U.S. at the time. This is the highest designation given by the NCI.

1999 - City of Hope launches a service to connect patients to supportive resources and its first caregivers, precursors to today's Sheri & Les Biller Patient and Family Resource Center.

2000 - Center for Biomedicine & Genetics is established to ensure that technological innovations are efficiently translated from the research lab to the clinical setting.

2001 - The National Institutes of Health, or NIH, designates City of Hope as a national center for isolating and

distributing islet cells for transplantation into patients with type 1 diabetes – one of only 10 such centers at the time. Islet cell transplantation is an investigational therapy with the potential to reverse type 1 diabetes.

2002 – In the triennial Combined Accreditation and Licensing Survey, regulators award City of Hope a score of 99 out of 100 – ranking in the top 1% of U.S. hospitals surveyed.

2003 – A \$5 million grant from the NIH and the National Center for Research Resources expands City of Hope's role in the emerging field of islet cell transplantation for type 1 diabetes.

2004 – The 2004 Patients Evaluation of Performance in California Survey, the largest patient satisfaction survey in the nation, names City of Hope as the only hospital in Southern California, and one of only four hospitals in the state, to receive the highest marks in all applicable categories from patients.

2005 – City of Hope Helford Clinical Research Hospital opens, providing an advanced patient-care environment where the medical team delivers the newest therapies.

2006 – City of Hope celebrates the 30th anniversary of its bone marrow transplantation program, with more than 7,500 procedures performed.

2007 – U.S. News & World Report names City of Hope one of "America's Best Hospitals" for cancer and urology.

2008 – The U.S. Patent and Trademark Office awards City of Hope's 200th patent for a drug designed to help fight complications of diabetes.

2009 – Leaders dedicate two new buildings: the Michael Amini Transfusion Medicine Center and the Arnold and Mabel Beckman Center for Cancer Immunotherapeutics & Tumor Immunology.

2010 – Scientists open a first-in-human clinical trial using genetically engineered neural stem cells that migrate to brain tumor cells and release anti-cancer chemotherapy.

City of Hope launches \$1 billion Power of Hope fundraising campaign.

2011 – Physicians perform City of Hope's 10,000th bone marrow or stem cell transplant, a milestone event for one of the largest and most successful transplant programs of its kind in the world.

2012 – Research results show that a combination therapy developed at City of Hope may be able to cure advanced type 1 diabetes.

2013 – City of Hope celebrates its centennial.

2014 – City of Hope was awarded more than \$72.9 million in research grants and received approximately \$249.8 million in revenues from patented technologies.

2015 – City of Hope earned its sixth consecutive Press Ganey Guardian of Excellence Award.

2016 – City of Hope announces an alliance with Translational Genomics Research Institute, one of the world's top genetics research and bioinformatics organizations and a pioneer in applying genomic analysis and bioinformatics to cancer drug development.

2017 – City of Hope leadership gathers press from around the country to publicly announce City of Hope's goal and expectation to cure type 1 diabetes in six years!

2018 – Behr Paint Company and their President Jeff Filley receive the *Spirit of Life*® Award.

2019 – Giles Bowman, senior vice president of The Home Depot receives the *Spirit of Life*® Award. It is a record year for the campaign.

2020 – *Spirit of Life*® honoree, Bradley Paulsen, chief operating officer, HD Supply hosted a "Call to Action" fundraising activity at the annual reception that generated over \$112,000 to benefit Dr. Linda Malkas' research.

2021 – *Spirit of Life*® honoring William P. "Bill" Boltz, executive vice president of merchandising at Lowe's was the largest "virtual" activity in City of Hope's history, raising over \$2.8 million dollars.

Edward S. Kim, M.D., M.B.A., joins City of Hope in fulfilling its promise of enhanced local access to cancer breakthroughs by leading its esteemed team of clinicians in Orange County.

A U.S. News & World Report “Top Doctor” and clinician world-renowned for his immense oncology experience, Kim is poised to drive innovation in cancer care and delivery, developing paradigms for translating research into clinical practice and introducing new therapies for the Orange County clinical network and planned Irvine campus.

Backed by a distinguished history of pioneering cancer research, Kim is among the country’s foremost experts in molecular prognostication — which advances cancer detection and personalized therapies — for lung, head and neck cancers. He’s served as a principal/co-principal investigator on numerous studies and protocols and authored/co-authored more than 200 published articles, book chapters and reviews in top-tier journals, such as *The Lancet*, *The Lancet Oncology*, *Journal of Clinical Oncology*, *Cancer Discovery*, *Cancer*, *Nature Medicine*, and *Cancer Prevention Research*.

Before joining City of Hope, Kim was chair of Solid Tumor Oncology and Investigational Therapeutics, the Donald S. Kim Distinguished Chair for Cancer Research and medical director of the Clinical Trials Office at Levine Cancer Institute, Atrium Health, in Charlotte, North Carolina, and professor of medicine at University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. He’s held many leadership roles, such as tenured associate professor in the Department of Thoracic/Head and Neck Medical Oncology at University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center. Kim recently completed his Master of Business Administration at University of North Carolina Kenan-Flagler Business School.

Prior to that, he served as president of The Home Depot Canada, where he was responsible for the sales, merchandising, ecommerce, supply chain, human resources, IT development and operations of 182 stores.

Lennie began his career at The Home Depot in 1992 as a merchant for Millwork and Building Materials before being named vice president of merchandising in 1997. In 2001, Lennie focused his leadership on the company's kitchen, bath and appliance departments and was promoted to senior vice president of décor in 2002.

Lennie also served as senior vice president of merchandising for the company, where he oversaw global sourcing, proprietary brands, environmental innovation and Your "other" Warehouse, a plumbing distributor owned by The Home Depot. Additionally, he was responsible for retail sales and operations in China and provided strategic direction on products and pricing to the company's Canadian and Latin American operations.

MEET BILL LENNIE, THE 2022 HONOREE

An advocate for City of Hope and a survivor

As a 26-year Home Depot veteran, Bill Lennie is intimately familiar with the industry icons who have led City of Hope's fundraising campaigns in recent decades. He was there in 1993 for his first *Spirit of Life*® celebration honoring Bill Patterson of HomeBase.

And as a cancer survivor, Lennie brings a personal passion to his new role as the fundraising lead for the California research and treatment facility, famous for its advances in the fight against cancer, diabetes and other life-threatening diseases.

Lennie was diagnosed in 1988.

"There's a wave of emotions that hit you when you're first diagnosed with cancer," he said. "First, you ask yourself, 'why me?' and 'what did I do to cause this?' But those questions quickly fade to 'what now?' And 'what's next?'"

When he was tapped as the 2022 *Spirit of Life* honoree, Lennie had no hesitation to jump on board for the chance to help City of Hope continue its innovative treatments and its groundbreaking research that impact more than one hundred million lives every year around the world.

"City of Hope is a global leader in the fight against cancer and other life-threatening diseases," he said. "Their groundbreaking research and innovative treatments impact over 100 million people globally each year. They create the answers to that question of 'what now?'"

"Their work depends on philanthropy and the generosity of industries like ours," he said. "Once you face that question of what now, you have a burning desire to do things to try to create that answer for other people who are faced with that situation."

It's not easy to explain the outpouring of support the hardware and homebuilding industry directs to City of Hope. But that support will be on full display at the *Spirit of Life* Gala, which will return live and in person Feb. 7 at the Hyatt Regency Orlando, Florida.

City of Hope was built on the principles of compassion, excellence, integrity and collaboration. "Their culture resonates strongly with the culture of our industry," Lennie said. "Our industry is filled with compassionate people who find ways to get involved and give back to their communities to make a difference for others' lives. I think that's why it resonates so well with our industry."

The Hardware and Homebuilding Industry has raised more than \$170 million over the years for Duarte, California-based, City of Hope. The fundraising efforts have been led by many of the best-known names in home improvement, including Leonard Herring and Robert Strickland of Lowe’s — the first honorees — and the executive leaders who founded The Home Depot, Bernie Marcus, Arthur Blank and Pat Farrah.

One of the common themes of past *Spirit of Life* honorees is the understanding that cancer affects us all, either directly or indirectly. Another is a desire to do something about it.

Following in the footsteps of iconic industry leaders to take on the *Spirit of Life* mantle comes with a mix of emotions, including pride and humility, Lennie said.

“And those feelings were immediately followed by a sense of purpose and responsibility for making sure that the 2022

campaign is successful,” he added. “You want to do everything possible to enable City of Hope to continue its profound work.”

MISSION POSSIBLE

The following is an excerpt from Bill Lennie’s remarks during a recent City of Hope Virtual Tour:

“All of us are impacted by cancer in our lifetime. For me, it has been as both a survivor of early-stage cancer at the age of 33, and, more recently, by the loss of my brother-in law Darin Bowe.

He was treated at the Mayo Clinic for a period of 10 years. City of Hope served as a consultant to Darin and his wife Kelly, providing confidence his treatment plans were correct and that everything possible was being done. We lost Darin on August 10, 2017. But those 10 years allowed Darin to see his son through high school, graduate college and start his professional career. You cannot put a value on that time.

“The Bellardi family’s story motivates us to stay on this mission and allow us to celebrate success. Darin’s story reminds us that we have much more work to do.”
