The **City of Hope Translational Development Center (TDC)** was established in 2018 to provide a “one-stop shop” to support the translation of innovative preclinical ideas, guiding the development of investigational products from pre-clinical proof-of-concept to phase 1 clinical trials. TDC provides resources including training, product development, manufacturing, regulatory filing, and clinical testing for the development of novel therapeutic entities from small molecules to cell and gene therapy products. TDC has operationalized these processes to serve academic partners as well as small to medium sized corporations.
